Road Numbers 560044, 560090



Built in June of 1970, these B-90-3 class excess height boxcars with Barber Roller Bearing trucks were designed to haul large and bulky commodities and primarily used for appliance service.



Penn Central Road Number 595027



This ex-Pennsylvania Railroad G33-class 65' mill gondola with Bettendorf trucks was built in 1949 and was designed to haul finished structural steel shapes and other bulky loads. It featured drop ends that allowed the gondola to carry loads longer than the car. Penn Central was formed through the merger of Pennsylvania Railroad and New York Central, and operated until 1976 when it was rolled into Conrail Corporation.

Canadian Pacific Road Numbers 305577, 305583

This skeleton log car with Barber Roller Bearing trucks was built for Canadian Pacific Railway in 1968, and belonged to a series of 25 cars. They were used to transport rough cut logs and finished power poles and features 4 rows of fixed bunks and a 170000-pound capacity.



CSX[®] Road Number 600634



Built in 1988, this centerbeam flat car with Barber Roller Bearing trucks was painted in a striking red and black scheme. It was used for carrying heavy finished wood loads, like plywood. With bulkheads on each end to prevent acceleration or deceleration load-shifting, the car design also features a centerbeam structure, which provides both lateral stability and support for shipment as well as simplifying loading and unloading cargo. CSX was formed through the 1986 mergers of Chessie System and Seaboard System/ Family Lines, and continues to operate today across more than 21,000 miles of track in the Eastern United States.

Medford, Talent, & Lakecreek Freelance RR 70s & 80s

Built by Medford, Talent & Lakecreek in 1980, these cars served rock quarries and other mining needs around the Rogue Valley. The Medford, Talent & Lakecreek Railroad was established in 1918 to serve the communities throughout Oregon's Rogue Valley, helping move commodities to the Southern Pacific interchanges. The success of the modest shortline revolved around serving various agricultural, timber, and manufacturing industries, as well as some passenger and tourist traffic in the region.



NdeM and Ferrocarril del Pacifico

These NdeM 89' flat cars were used in COFC service, and painted in the 1980s NdeM paint scheme. Ferrocarriles Nacionales de México, also known as NdeM, was Mexico's government-owned railroad from 1938 until 1998, when the company was divided into four private railroads and regions.





Burlington Northern Weathered Caboose 3-Pack




These Burlington Northern cabooses were built for the CB&Q in the early 1930s. Later, they wore a BN Green paint scheme from the late 1970s until retirement. Burlington Northern was formed through the mergers of Great Northern and Northern Pacific in 1970, and then merged with ATSF in 1995 to form BNSF. BNSF is one of the largest freight railroads in the country with over 32,000 miles of rail.



Burlington Northern Santa Fe with Coal Load 8-Pack





TTPX 3-Pack with Cable Reel Load




Built for TTX, these NSH72-class bulkhead flatcars with Barber Roller Bearing trucks were used to carry structural steel and pipes, as well as logs and other long commodities. The reinforced bulkheads provide load protection as well as prevent shifting during transit. TTX was established in 1955 as "Trailer Train," and as their business evolved simply became "TTX" in a 1991 rebranding effort.

ATSF Reefer 4-Pack Accepting Pre-Orders Through October 31st



This 40-foot double-sheathed wood ice-reefer, with vertical brake wheel, is black with yellow sides and runs on Andrews trucks. Built in the early-1920s and rebuilt in 1930s, this reefer used 40-ton capacity trucks. This RR-W class car belonged to a series of over 1,250 similar cars, and could be seen in trains all across the country.
