With a wood deck and tie-down channels, the cars can be used for a number of other purposes, including hauling structural steel shapes and other bulky industrial loads. These BNSF-owned flat cars were built in 1967 by Thrall for ATSF. Burlington Northern was formed through the mergers of Great Northern and Northern Pacific in 1970, and then merged with ATSF in 1995 to form BNSF. BNSF is one of the largest freight railroads in the country with over 32,000 miles of rail.

### Road Number 758007



This Conrail Maintenance of Way flat car with Bettendorf trucks was modified to include a rack to hold pre-fabricated track switch panels and other large flat assemblies. New York Central merged with its rival, the Pennsylvania Railroad, in 1968 to form Penn Central, which went bankrupt two years later and was merged into Conrail in 1976.

Belonging to a series of ex-CB&Q cars, these BNSF 3,200 cubic foot capacity cars with Barber Roller Bearing trucks were built by American Car & Foundry in the mid-1960s. Burlington Northern was formed through the mergers of Great Northern and Northern Pacific in 1970, and then merged with ATSF in 1995 to form BNSF. BNSF is one of the largest freight railroads in the country with over 32,000 miles of rail.

Under the ownership of the Vermont Rail System since 1997, it operates both freight and passenger services.

This Bx-188-class excess height boxcar with Barber Roller Bearing trucks was rebuilt in the early 1970s from a smaller car built a few years earlier. It featured a cushioned underframe and movable bulkheads. Founded in 1859, Santa Fe was one of the largest railroads in North America up until 1996, when it merged with Burlington Northern to form BNSF.

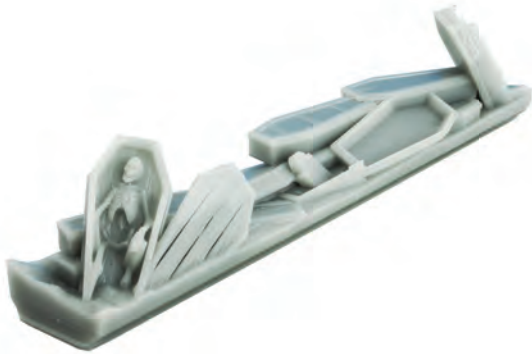

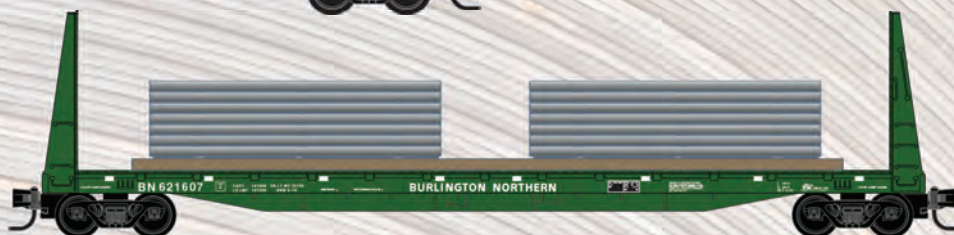

In early 1991, Burlington Northern received an order of 16 single Husky-Stack cars from Gunderson, accommodating containers up to 48' in the lower well position. 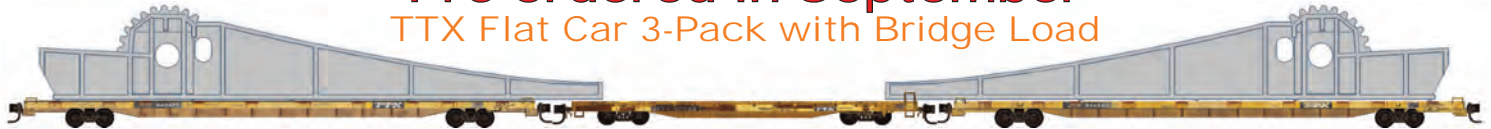

In 2022, a 60' boxcar was decorated by GATX as the centerpiece for the "Save the Monarch Butterfly - 60,000 Tree Challenge" North American boxcar tour. Kansas City Southern, Canadian Pacific, GATX and several other organizations collaborated to create the campaign. The annual migratory journey of the Monarch Butterfly is a long one - from the Windsor, Canada area, through the United States, and ends near Monterrey in Michoacán State of Mexico. This boxcar tour paralleled this migratory path of these amazing pollinators to raise \$100,000 to help reestablish the still-threatened Monarch population, by planting 60,000 oyamel trees at El Rosario Monarch Butterfly Sanctuary in Michoacán, Mexico.

ATSF cabooses were often rebuilt later in life and modernized with additional amenities for crews, including refrigerators and new seating areas. These cabooses feature different paint schemes to denote type of service. The Mineral Brown paint scheme denoted local service only, the Indian Red scheme with the White Cupola denoted PC radio equipment and/or transfer service, while the all-red caboose was for mainline freight service.

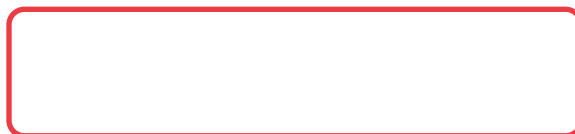
