Prototype and Model:

Equipped for transporting a wide variety of chemicals, the chemical tank car and its stainless steel (V4A) tank is an indispensable and modern transportation method for many companies in the chemical industry. These cars are designed to safely carry a wide variety of substances, partly through insulation and partly through heating. With a volume of 72 m³ and a tare weight of 24.5 t, a maximum of 65.5 t can be loaded. The tank's 1.5% incline ensures good drainage for full emptying of residual quantities.

Prototype and Model:

Although the V200.0 locomotives proved to be very successful, increased traffic volume by the end of the 1950s made it necessary for the Deutsche Bundesbahn to develop the series with more powerful locos. In 1960, Krauss-Maffei was awarded the contract to develop and build the V200.1, which, in addition to more powerful drive motors, featured a roof and front end redesigned from its predecessors. The V200.1 series locomotives were intended for use on the Allgäu Railway, the Black Forest Railway, and on the Vogelflug Line between Germany and Denmark. However, a large number of the beautifully designed locomotives, known from 1968 as the 221 series, spent their last service years in the arduous freight traffic of the Ruhr area, until they were taken out of service in 1988.

The completely new PIKO model will delight with numerous realistic details. The cab doors and cab side windows can be opened. The control stand is illuminated. The diesel motors and other equipment in the engine room are visible through the side windows. The roof area features see-through radiator grilles with separate fan blades beneath. Additionally the 37461 model is equipped with a PIKO XP-series sound decoder, offering not only numerous authentic sounds, but also chassis lighting and engine room lighting. This model also includes two fandriven pulsed smoke generators, reproducing the exhaust of the twin diesel motors. And as a final touch, a third smoke unit replicates the exhaust from the steam generator boiler.






