Road Numbers 81317, 81318



This F68AH flatcar with Barber Roller Bearing trucks was built by Bethlehem Steel in 1974 for TTX and has a 263,000-pound capacity. This bulkhead flatcar is used to carry structural steel and pipes, as well as logs and other long commodities. The reinforced bulkheads provide load protection as well as prevent shifting during transit. TTX was established in 1955 as "Trailer Train," and as their business evolved simply became "TTX" in a 1991 rebranding effort.

This General American-Evans Corporation boxcar with Bettendorf trucks was leased to the Pennsylvania Railroad and featured Damage Free (DF) loaders. Founded in 1898, GATC went through several name changes before becoming GATX in 1975.

Southern Pacific®

Road Number 676634



Rebuilt in 1978, this B-100-7-R class boxcar with Barber Roller Bearing trucks featured a cushioned underframe, Car-Pac Loaders, and Insulation. Southern Pacific was a Class 1 railroad from 1865 until 1996, when it was absorbed by Union Pacific after falling on hard times financially in the 1970s and 1980s.

MRL/ex-Railbox

Road Number 21408



Built in 1980 for Railbox, this 50' boxcar with Barber Roller Bearing trucks soon made its way to the Montana Rail Link fleet. MRL was founded in 1987, and was a profitable and critical link between BNSF and Union Pacific interchange points in the Western United States.

A Class 1 railroad is defined as any railroad with annual revenue of more than \$504,803,294 (the 1992 threshold of \$250 million, set by the ICC, adjusted for inflation). There are six Class 1 Railroads operating in the United States; BNSF, CSX, CN, CPKC, NS and UP. Founded in 1859, Santa Fe was one of the largest railroads in North America up until 1996, when it merged with Burlington Northern to form BNSF.

Built in April of 1965, this three bay covered hopper with Barber Roller Bearing trucks has a 200,000 pound capacity and previous to CSX ownership, it belonged to Family Lines. In 1982, the L&N merged with the Seaboard Coast Line and Atlantic Coast Line to form Seaboard System. Seaboard later merged with Chessie System to form CSX.

Conrail**Road Number 220998**

This 60' double-plug-door boxcar with Barber Roller Bearing trucks was re-built by Conrail in the mid-1990s and repainted into the Conrail Quality paint scheme. With a capacity of 263,000 pounds and 7100 cubic feet, it had plenty of space for appliances and other bulky cargoes. New York Central merged with its rival, the Pennsylvania Railroad, in 1968 to form Penn Central, which went bankrupt two years later and was merged into Conrail in 1976.

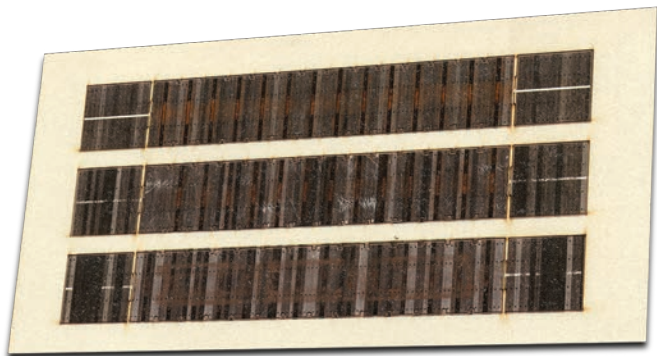
This ex-Reading, Delaware & Hudson flatcar with Bettendorf trucks is carrying a cable suspension load. The original Delaware & Hudson operated 1,581 miles in the Northeastern United States from 1823 until 1991, when Canadian Pacific absorbed the rail line.

Cattle Guard and Fence Kit

Cattle guards are designed to keep livestock contained and safe on designated property. The design consists of a series of parallel bars placed over a road or railroad track, allowing the vehicles or trains to pass freely. The gaps between the bars are wide enough that cattle perceive it as a dangerous obstacle. They instinctively avoid stepping onto the guard because their hooves could slip through or get stuck. This cattle guard is based on a mid-century design, commonly found all-across the Western United States, with some still in use today.

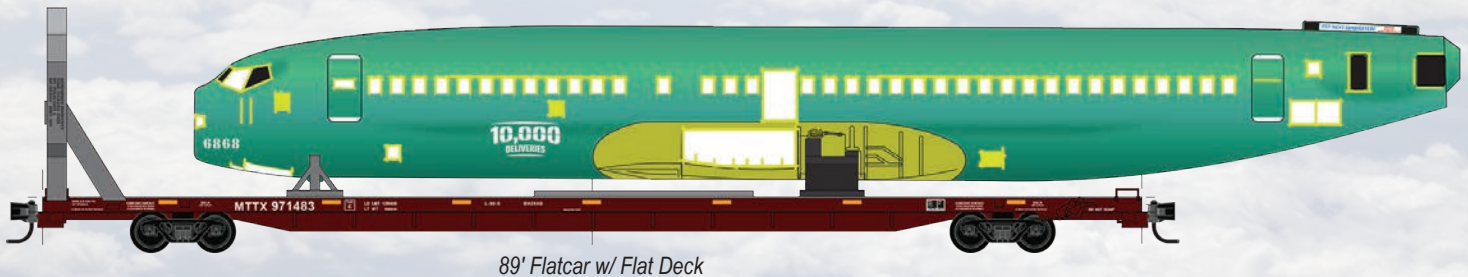

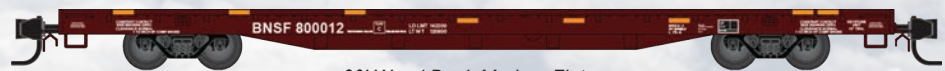
MTTX/BNSF Flatcar w/ 10,000th Fuselage 2-Pack



This BH20AB-class 89' MTTX flatcar was used for general purpose bulk loading of construction equipment, industrial machinery, or in this case, the 10,000th delivery of a 737, on its way to Renton, WA, for final assembly and eventual delivery to Southwest Airlines. This momentous occasion occurred in 2018. The flatcar features deck mounted purpose-built pedestals and specialized retainment devices that allows the safe loading and transportation of this unique load. Also included is a BNSF 60' flatcar used as a buffer car.

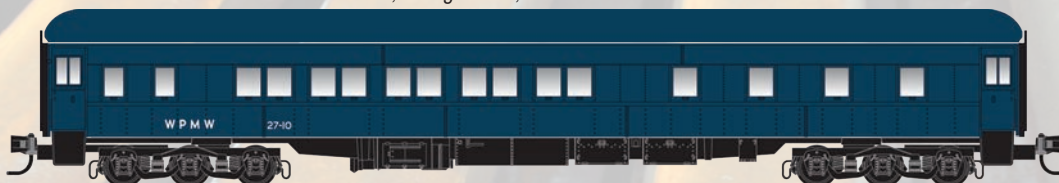

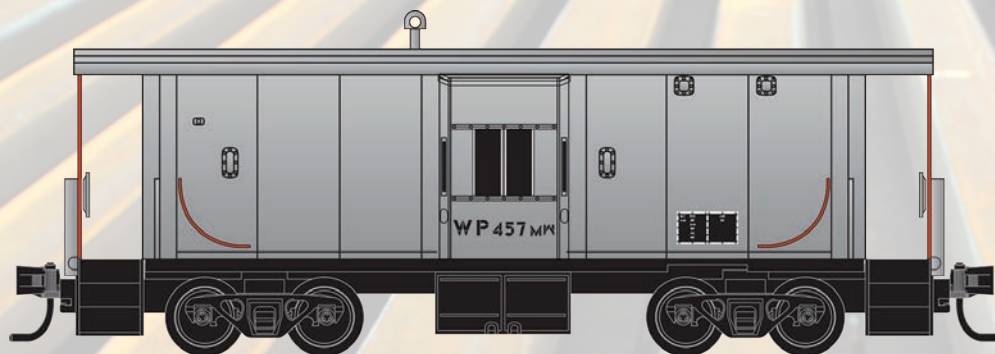

Conrail was a Class 1 railroad operating in the Northeastern United States from 1976 until 1999. Conrail was formed by the federal government through the mergers of bankrupt Penn Central, Erie Lackawanna, and other roads. Conrail eventually turned a profit, and in the late 1980s it was privatized, and continued operating until the late 1990s when it was split between Norfolk Southern and CSX.

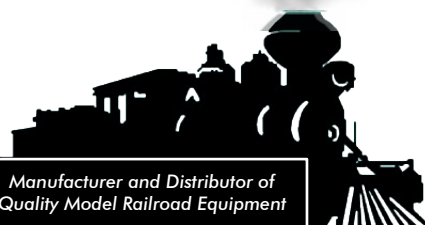
