This 1778 cubic foot capacity drop-end mill gondola with ASF Ride Control trucks was built for Denver & Rio Grande Western, and was designed to haul finished structural steel shapes and other bulky loads featuring drop ends that allowed the gondola to carry loads longer than the car. D&RGW was formed in 1870 and operated the highest mainline railroad in the United States through the Colorado Rockies at an altitude of 10,240 feet.

Built in 1978, this 50' boxcar with Roller Bearing trucks was leased from Helm Leasing to Chessie System in 1985, and featured Damage Free Loaders and Hennessey Door Openers. Chessie System was formed through the 1972 mergers of Chesapeake & Ohio, Baltimore & Ohio, and Western Maryland. It remained one of the largest East coast railroads until 1986 when Seaboard System merged with Chessie to form today's rail giant, CSX Transportation.






